


The MOFR website is a corporate website of the Ministry of Forestry and Research. It is built using Joomla CMS. The website URL can be accessed at:

Internal User Access


- Users can login to publish data

With the steady growth of online presence on websites via mobile phones, computers, and tablets, they have become determining factors for an organization's success.



- The system was built using Joomla Content Management System (CMS) and these latest scripts and framework technology: PHP 7, HTML5, CSS4 and Bootstrap
- The system back-end database is MySQL
- The CMS framework is Joomla CMS
- The website is hosted locally at Our Telekom webhosting.
- The system has a three-tier architecture with presentation logic, business logic, and data logic
- The system is dynamic where content changes and updates can be done by non-IT staff
- The system supports GIS and social media collaboration, such as links to Facebook and other sites
